- 4. Bargaining Chairperson Larry McKiernan (SUI) will update the Council of the small additional 2016-2017 raise generated by the contract formula and negotiated changes for Head Start Bargaining Unit members.
- 5. The Reduction in Force continues to loom over the District. Executive Director Kathy Schlotz will update the Council on the lay-off notices and the hearings.
