## Council: October 16, 2018 · 3:30-5 p.m. at the MTA CC

- 1. Bargaining Chairperson Larry McKiernan (SUI) will update the Council. The two teams generally meet each week. Since the Board opened every article in the contract, the process is long and intense.
  - a. Article II Recognition has been completed. A tentative agreement was signed.
  - b. Article III. Definitions is currently being discussed and proposals are being analyzed.
  - c. Article IV. Hours and Assignments is currently being discussed and proposals are being analyzed.
  - d. Article XIII. Transfer and Reassignment Policy is currently being discussed and proposals are being analyzed.
  - e. The Head Start memorandum of understanding signed April 4, 2017 has been revisited.
  - 2. Political Action Chairperson Jaime Quintero (FPA) will speak on the November 6 election. This is the last time Council will meet prior to this landmark change in the school board.
    - a. None of the three incumbents (Ben Cardenas, Hector Chacon, and Lani Cupchoy) are candidates.
    - b. The Association endorsed Jennifer Gutierrez, Miki Moreno, and Marisol Uribe.
    - c. Phone banking is hosted at the MTA office Monday Thursday from after the Board Day until 8 p.m.
    - d. The candidates canvass potential voters Saturdays and Sundays.

- 3. The Trust Fund provides lifetime contributions for health insurance for qualified retirees. Trustee Andy Shinn (BGI) will review the changes made to the plan this year.
