1. The Association will hold a remote Council meeting Tuesday, April 21. The meeting will be held on WebEx. The process is as follows.

On April 12, you will receive an email with your link to the WebEx meeting on. If you have never participated in a WebEx meeting, you will be asked to install the Cisco WebEx app. Follow the instructions in your browser. Once this process takes place, you will be able to join the meeting.

If you already have the Cisco WebEx app installed on your device, then you will be taken directly to the meeting room. Your meeting will begin shortly.

- 2. Bargaining Chairperson David Navar (WGE) will review the MOU between the District and the Association concerning school closures and distance learning. This is an ongoing process. President Doug Patzkowski will talk about steps to keep members safe through the next few months. He will also outline what we know about distribution of devices for awaiting students.
- 3. Charter schools continue to be an issue even as schools are closed. President Doug Patzkowski will update the Council. Kipp Academy's petition was denied by the Board of Education Wednesday, April 8. Kipp Academy may appeal to the Los Angeles County Office of Education.
- 4. The Board of Education election is scheduled for November 2020. Political Action Chairperson Jaime Quintero will lay out the revised plan for endorsements. Interviews and the forum will be conducted remotely,
- 5. The proposed MUSD calendars were posted for two months. The Council will vote to approve calendars for 2021-2022, 2022-2023, and 2023-2024.
- 6. The Council will also vote on the MTA 2020-2021 calendar.
- 7. Nominations will close for Executive Committee and CTA State Council and Alternate.
