The District and the Association have developed joint memorandum of understanding (MOU) the boards ing minutes and staff development day site specific waivers.

The MTA Site Specific Waiver Policy has been amended. Now, any Bargaining Unit member can request a vote prior to the Faculty Club recommendation.
