District Section 125 Open Enrollment Is Now!

Between October 15 and November 15 you may enroll in the 2005 Section 125 program. Under this program, you can establish pre-tax payroll deductions to pay for:

- Child care expenses;
- Medical expenses; and,
- Health insurance premiums.

According to Federal Law

- Dependent care deductions are limited to \$5,000 per plan
- Dependent care reimbursement can only be made from funds currently on deposit in your reimbursement account
- Medical expense reimbursements can be made up to the amount of the total deduction regardless of the balance in your account at the time of the request. The district plan limits deductions to \$3,000 in any plan year. (Raised from \$2,000 last year.)
- All reimbursements require the submission of both a claim form and a receipt from the provider.
 - Any funds left in your account at the end of the plan year will be lost.
