WILL THE SOCIAL SECURITY OFFSET EVER BE ELIMINATED?

NEA Director Margie Granado (MTA) has reported on the progress of the elimination of the Social Security offset for STRS recipients.

There is good news and bad news on the Government Pension Offset (GPO) and the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP). The good news is that there are now 323 co-sponsors in the House and 29 co-sponsors in the Senate signed on to repeal legislation. This means that there should be plenty of support for the repeal. The bad news is that the legislation has yet to go forward for a vote on the floor of Congress. With the current Congressional session set to end soon, it is unlikely that a vote will be held during this session. When the 110th Congress convenes in January, NEA will have to start the legislative process again from the beginning.
