# Bargaining Begins Friday, March 5

Bargaining Chairperson Andy Shinn (BGI) announced that negotiations will be with the District Friday, March 5. The traditional negotiations start time of early May has been moved up in appreciation of the March 15 lay-off deadline.

The Association has not opened any items for negotiations at this time. The District is the "moving party" in terms of opening articles of the contract. The members of the Bargaining Team will have the first opportunity to hear the District's proposals and determine next steps. The members of the MTA team are prepared to negotiate through the week of March 8.

### Petitions Are Circulating for the Repeal Tax Loopholes Act

The California Teachers Association (CTA) is circulating petitions to add a proposition to the June 2010 ballot. Petition 09-0058 proposes to eliminate corporate tax breaks.

The targeted tax breaks include:

- ◆ The "single-sales factor". This allows multi-state corporations to choose whether they will be taxed on property, payroll or sales.
- ♦ Loss carry-backs. This allows corporations that are experiencing losses in California's current economy to get refunds for taxes paid up to two years previously.
- ◆ Tax credit-sharing. This allows companies with more tax credits than they can use to distribute the tax credits to affiliates.
