
All Employees Must Enroll for Dental by Oct. 1

The open enrollment period for dental and vision is also this month. How-

ever, the plan year for dental and vision is October 1 - September 1. This means all changes will be effective almost immediately. Please note, if you do not wish to make changes to your health insurance benefits, there is no need to re-enroll. However, every employee of the Montebello Unified School District must re-enroll in the Dental Plan. To re-enroll in the Dental plan, please attend one of the meetings or download the MetLife Enrollment Form from www.montebello.k12.ca.us fill it out and return it to the Benefits Department at the District Office by October 1, 2010. Note: there is no additional cost to the employee for dental and vision insurance. Employees may opt for family coverage dental and vision regardless of whether single, 2 party, or family coverage is selected for health insurance.

Now Is the Time to Ask Questions and Make **Changes In Health Plans**

The Open Enrollment period for CalPERS health insurance plans ends Friday.

October 1. This is this time Bargaining Unit members can select among the 3 Blue Cross PPOs. 2 Blue Shield HMOs, and Kaiser. This is also the time to add dependents. Beginning January 1 children are eligible through their 26th birthday. You may enroll your adult children during open enrollment. If you

make no changes during open enrollment, your health insurance will continue as the same plan in 2011. The out-of-paycheck deductions will be for the 2011 rates listed to the right.
