## **Catastrophic Leave Bank Annual Report**

The Catastrophic Leave Bank (CLB) is available to all certificated employees of the District. Bargaining Unit members may donate a minimum of one day per year to be eligible for withdrawal. A catastrophic illness or injury is defined as a condition that is expected to incapacitate the employee for an extended period of time and create a financial hardship. Days can only be withdrawn from the CLB following the exhaustion of all of one's illness leave and difference pay. The CLB Committee approves 20 days per request for a maximum of 60 days.

At this time there are 1732 days in the CLB. This year 195 members donated a total of 196 days. Donations were due no later than November 1. The total number of days that can be withdrawn in one year is 220. More information is available at montebelloteachers.org under the Contract button.
