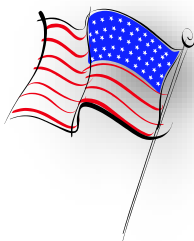

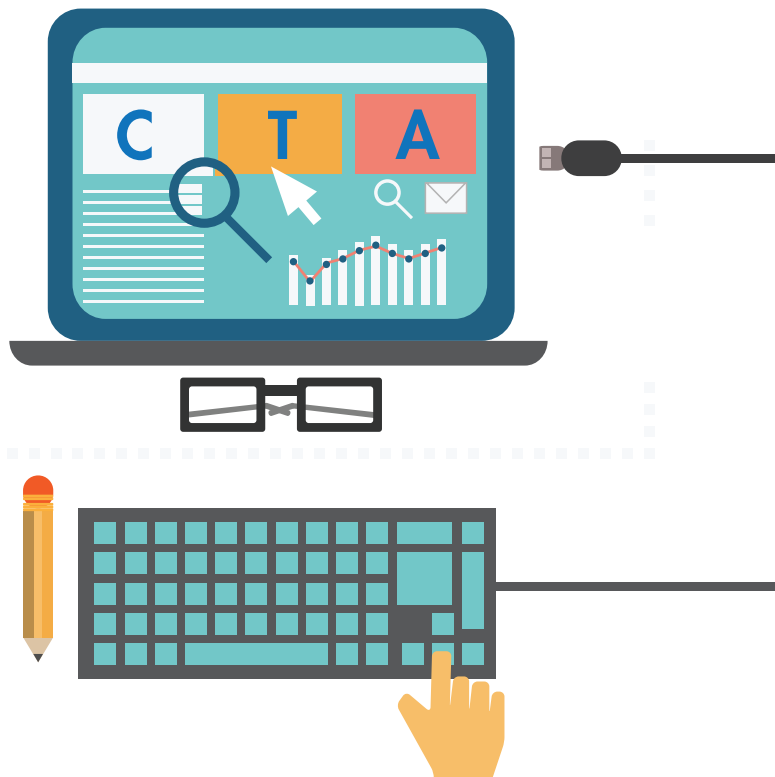
Our Bargaining Team Continues to Work Toward Settlement

The two teams have discussed both the Article XIV. Health and Welfare Benefits and Article XVI. Leave Policy. The teams met Monday, September 22 and are scheduled to meet again Wednesday, October 8.

Administrator to Notify if Employee Is Not Selected for a Voluntary Transfer

In the event that a qualified Bargaining Unit member is not granted a voluntary transfer, the appropriate administrator is to notify the applicant in writing prior to interviewing other applicants. (Article XIII. Section D.1.d.4.)
