Notices Arrived Tuesday & RIF Hearings Set for April

Following a Special Meeting of the Board of Education Monday, March 13, Reduction in Force (RIF) layoff notices were sent to **176 probationary and permanent certificated non-management employees**. The hearings for the lay-off are set for the week we return from Spring Break.

63 Probationary Employees Receive Notice of Non-Reelect

In a surprise twist, the Board of Education sent 63 probationary employees non-reelect notices. This action deprives each of the 63 employees the opportunity for a hearing and a place on the rehire list. The Association is currently investigating options to regain the rights of our members.

“Show Your Work” CBO Rojas Unfair Labor Practice Filed

The Association has attempted to work with the District regarding the minimal salary increase generated by the contractual formula. Since the District's 2016-2017 revenues were more than projected, an increase in our salaries is due.

CBO Rojas submitted the First Interim December 15 and verified calculations that our salaries must be adjusted.

The District has not implemented the raise nor provided information on the calculation. The Unfair Labor Practice Charge goes to the Public Employment Relations Board.

Doug Patzkowski Is Our WHO Honoree

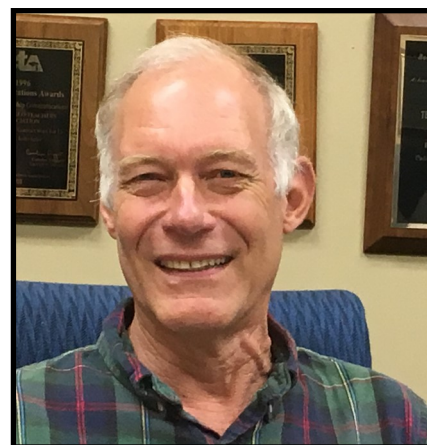

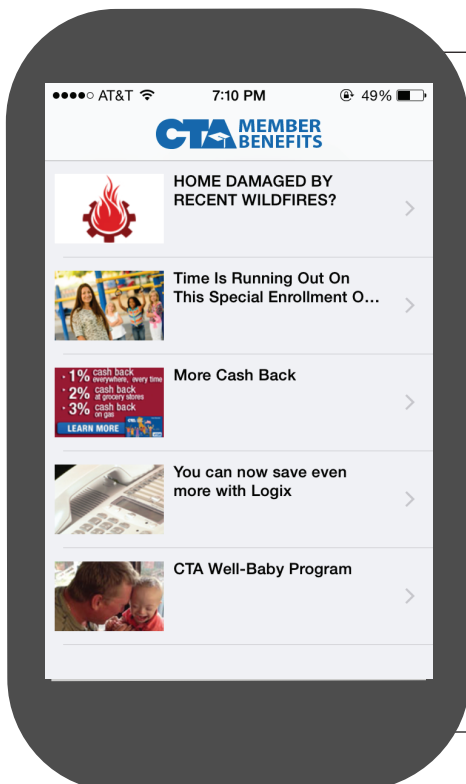
