The District Could Not Find a Substitute Teacher And I Was Assigned Additional Students!

Article IV. Hours and Assignments Section F.11 states:

Any elementary or intermediate Bargaining Unit member who is assigned a portion of another Bargaining Unit member's class shall be additionally compensated at his or her per diem rate of pay proportionate to the time involved and students as determined by the principal. For the purposes of this paragraph an occasion is defined as no more than six (6) students for no more than one day or an entire class for no more than one hour. This provision must be utilized on an equitable basis at all levels. This provision cannot be used to supplant the employment of substitutes.
