
California Gears Up to Pass Proposition 55

Members all over the State are participating in volunteer efforts to pass Proposition 55 on the November 8 ballot. This is the initiative that determines school funding and influences the formula in the 2017-2018 wage calculation.

Let's Pass The Children's Education and Health care Protection Act of 2016: Proposition 55.



- Extends the personal income tax portion of Proposition 30 for 12 years.
- Will raise \$8-11 billion a year that will go directly into a special fund that supports K-12 education and community colleges which frees up precious State General Fund monies for social services and higher education.
- Strict accountability provisions and will not permit any of the funds to go towards bureaucracy or administrative costs.
- Without Proposition 55, we risk going back to the days of massive education cuts, teacher layoffs, and huge budget holes for our healthcare programs.
- California is 46th in the nation in per pupil funding according to Education Weekly Quality Counts 2016 (2012-2013 data).

The Contract Defines Maximum Meeting Hours for Individuals


The contract provides for the following meeting hours per school month (listed on the back of this *Contact*).

- **2** hours within the Board Day
- 3 hours outside the Board Day (with one week advance notice in writing)
- **4** evenings per year

The meeting hours may be changed by agreement of the Faculty Club Chairperson and the Principal no less than 20 days prior to implementation. In no case shall the meeting hours total more than 5.

The Board day is 7 hours and 15 minutes. The standard Board Day is 8 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. Ask your site administrator for the official Board Day at your site.

The District defines a school month. School months are generally 4 weeks long. The "Staff Development Months" calendar is available at montebelloteachers.org.
