MetLife Dental at 100% For All Beginning January 1, 2017

The Insurance Committee has amended the MetLife Dental Benefit to 100% coverage for Bargaining Unit members beginning with the new plan year in January. In the past, the plan was “tiered” meaning the first time you used the benefit you have 70% coverage, the next year (if you went to the dentist during the year) you are covered at 80%, the next year 90%, and finally in the fourth year you are covered 100%.

From now on, you and your dependents are covered with 100% from the beginning including: newborn babies, new spouses, and adopted children.

The MetLife Dental plan is capped at \$1750 per calendar year. For more information regarding your dental coverage, contact the Benefits Department at extension 2338.

Members Commit to Passing School Funding Initiative

The first goal is to talk to each Bargaining Unit member in the Montebello Teachers Association about the importance of passing Proposition 55 this November. The second goal is to talk to likely voters about why continuing financial support for public schools is vital.

Montebello Unified will **lose approximately 15% of state funding** if the initiative is not passed. That's more than \$40 million per year. The District is already considering cuts in personnel in the event that the law is not passed on Tuesday, November 8.
