If Retirement Is Your Future, Keep Reading

You are eligible to receive your State Teachers Retirement System (STRS) the day after you retire. If you retire June 12, you begin earning STRS the next weekday, June 15. **Cancelled Events**

- You must submit your paperwork to STRS at least 45 days prior to your retirement date to receive your first regular payment in a timely fashion. If you wait to submit the paperwork you earn the same amount, but the payment may be late.
- It's all electronic! You will receive a direct deposit to the financial institution of your choice.
- ◆ Your CalPERS medical insurance will be deducted from your STRS pension direct deposit.
- If you have 15 years of service to the District you can retire from the District and receive medical insurance through CalPERS.
- If you are under age 67 when you retire, the District will reimburse up to \$1396.21 per month (in 2020).
- If you are 65 or older, you must apply for Medicare Parts A & B through Social Security.
- If you are 67 or older when you retire, the MTA Retiree Supplemental Health Plan (The Trust) will reimburse you up to \$500 per month (in 2020) if you meet eligibility requirements.
- Retirement is a "qualifying event" so you can change your insurance options even though it is not Open Enrollment.
