Anxiety Is Up and Morale Is Down

Bargaining Forums Reveal Trends

Conversations with members confirm concerns regarding summer programs, the 2021-2022 school year, and beyond:

- Reduced class sizes and caseloads are imperative.
- Safety protocols must be published and confirmed before in-person settings begin.
- Members must be fairly compensated including: instruction, professional services, assessment, counseling, and preparation.

The District is receiving unprecedented stimulus funding - a total of \$169,712,512 additional dollars so far. Additional Learning Loss Mitigation funds are anticipated with the State budget next month.

The Board of Education adopted plan for the <u>Expanded Learning Opportunity Grant</u> includes: providing summer school, accelerating progress to close the achievement gaps, and integrated supports to address barriers to learning.

Bargaining Chairperson David Navar reports, negotiations have gone at an unprecedentedly slow pace. The Board, the Interim Superintendent, and members agree on the priorities. Funds are available. Students and employees need the District to commit now. Class size, case loads, and safety protocols—let's get this done! The two teams met on the summer programs MOU Thursday. The next meeting is Tuesday.
