Bargaining Surveys Are Due Wednesday, March 23

The Bargaining team emailed you a survey focusing on the Class Size MOU and the Bargaining Reopeners. The current agreement automatically opens Article VIII. Class Size and Article XII. Wages . Council passed an <u>Educational Justice Resolution</u> which calls for negotiating Community Schools.

Pay Increase Expected on April 1 Pay Warrant

The 6 percent negotiated increase in salary will be included in your April 1 pay warrant. The retro payment for the difference between what your were paid and the increase between July 1 and February 28 should be received no later than June 1, 2022.

We Seek a Permanent Superintendent of Schools

Council passed a motion Tuesday, March 15:

MTA advocates for the hiring of a permanent, full-time superintendent of schools, employed by Montebello Unified, who prioritizes the continued growth and success of all students, and the well-being of all employees.

BoE Rejects Superintendent Search Timeline

The March 16 BoE packet included a recommendation to continue the Executive Services Consulting Agreement with Capitol Advisors, LLC. approving Dr. Skvarna to provide services *equivalent* to an Interim Superintendent of schools through **2024**. Board Member Marisol Uribe recommended a friendly amendment to begin the Superintendent Search July 1, 2022 and conclude no later than June 13, 2023. She

advocated for a smooth transition and attention to stakeholder needs. The motion died for a lack of a second. **The Capitol Advisers**, **LLC consultancy contract is now continued through June 30, 2024 with a vote of 4:1.**
