## **Compensation for Combination Classes TK-Grade 5**

For the 2022-2023 school year, effective Monday, August 15, the District shall make every effort to prevent combination classes. Where combination multigrade classes are unavoidable, a four hundred dollar (\$400) stipend per instructional month (defined as one instructional day in the MUSD Professional Learning calendar), will be paid to the following:

- Bargaining Unit members teaching a general education combination class in TK through grade 5 with more than one grade level of students.
- 2. Bargaining Unit members teaching a special education class with more than two grade levels.
