TENTATIVE AGREEMENT REACHED BETWEEN MTA AND MUSD

The MTA Bargaining Team achieved a Tentative Agreement with the district on Wednesday evening after months of negotiations.

There will be a 4% ongoing pay increase to the Salary Schedule starting in July 2023. A check retroactive to July 2023 will be issued sometime in the summer.

Class Size for the 2024-2025 school year will be based on an MOU agreed upon yesterday with numbers that are generally lower than those currently in the Contract.

There will be an in-person Ratification Meeting at the MTA Conference Center on Tuesday, April 30, at 4:00 p.m. All members are invited to attend to receive more information from the Bargaining Team.

The Ratification Packet will be available on the MTA Website on Tuesday, April 30, after the meeting.

A virtual meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 1, at 4:00 p.m. for any members who were unable to attend the Monday meeting in person.

Members will receive a ballot at their personal email account on Tuesday, April 30, and they will have until the following Tuesday, May 7, to submit their vote on ratification of the Tentative Agreement.
