Minimum Days

In order for teachers to conduct parent conferences, the excess minutes above the state mandate are allocated as follows:

Full Day

TK/Kindergarten 10 days (5 in the fall and 5 in the spring) are offered. The instructional day minutes are reduced, but never less than 240 minutes.

Grades 1-5 10 days (5 in the fall and 5 in the spring) are offered. The instructional

day minutes are reduced, but are never less than 240 minutes.

Grades 6-8 8 days (5 in the fall and 3 in the spring) are offered. The instructional

day minutes are reduced, but are never less than 240 minutes.

High School Minimum days are used for finals

Reconfigured Schedules
