As Professional Learning Communities GAE teachers will collaborate to improve student achievement by:

- 1. Setting SMART goals to monitor student learning (follow cycle of effective instruction),
- 2. Planning and collaborating on instruction,
- 3. Developing common assessments to measure student learning (using available technology),
- 4. Designing appropriate interventions within and beyond the school day for at-risk students,

In order to create this time, the staff has agreed to add minutes to four days a week and reduce the schedule on Wednesday.

2 Wednesdays per month will be dedicated to PLC/Whole-Staff meetings and 2 Wednesdays will be set aside for grade level family meetings. Both sets of meetings will serve the purposes outlined above. One to two Mondays as needed will be used to further our professional development. The teachers through the Site Leadership Team will inform this process. Teacher Leads will also contribute to this process of identifying and fulfilling professional needs to improve student achievement.
