

The teachers at Garfield Elementary school met on 5/1/12 and with the concurrence of the principal, have reached consensus on changing the average daily instructional minutes to allow time for the following:

As Professional Learning Communities/Data-Teams GAE teachers will collaborate to improve student achievement by:

- 1. Setting SMART goals to monitor student learning (follow data teams process)
- 2. Planning and collaborating on instruction,
- 3. Developing common assessments to measure student learning (using available technology),
- 4.Designing appropriate interventions within and beyond the school day for at-risk students,
- 5. Participating in professional development opportunities and,
- 6.Addressing any other areas pertinent to student achievement/activities.

In order to create this time, the staff has agreed to add minutes to four days a week and reduce the schedule on Wednesday.

1 Wednesday per month will be dedicated to PLC/Whole-Staff meetings and 3 Wednesdays will be set aside for grade level-data teams/family meetings. Both sets of meetings will serve the purposes outlined above.

One to two Mondays as needed will be used to further our professional development. The teachers through the Site Leadership Team will inform this process. Teacher Leads will also contribute by identifying and fulfilling professional needs to improve student achievement.
